



STATE LEGISLATIVE PROCESS





DPA Set-Aside for Descendants of Slaves

- ✓ AB 57 (McKinnor) reserves a portion of the Home Purchase Assistance Program's moneys for eligible descendants of slaves
- ✓ Similar to prior year bill, part of reparations package





- Stop new **building standards**
- Accelerate state **permit review** for reconstruction
- Expedite **construction of ADUs** in the Coastal Zone
- Keep displaced Californians housed
- **Prohibit evictions** if a tenant shelters wildfire victims or their pet
